Dear Competitor.

1. All entries that have been received have been accepted – an entry list in Class order will be available at scrutiny. The onus is on the Competitor to make sure that he or she is entered in the correct class for the event at Scrutiny.
2. Mechanical and Documentation Scrutiny will take place between 06:00 hrs and 09:30 on Saturday 29th September 2018 at St Angelo Enniskillen, Co Fermanagh. **A Timing Strut MUST** be fitted to the front of the vehicle as per 2018 MSA Yearbook.
3. A Drivers briefing will take place at 09:30 hrs on Saturday 29th September 2018 at St Angelo in the hanger where Scrutiny and Documentation will take place. **All Drivers MUST attend this briefing!**
4. The First official practice timed run which will start immediately after the compulsory parade lap of the circuit, the parade lap must be completed by all competing vehicles as this is your first practice lap. There will be 2 Practice and 3 Official Timed Runs given on the day. Each run consists of 2 laps giving a total of approximately 2.5 miles in length.
5. Tyre warming will **ONLY** be allowed in the designated area on the approach to the Track Start Line. This section will be sign-posted to show the start and finish of the tyre warming area, and will be monitored by a Club Official for adherence.
6. **Failure in attempting to drive through a Chicane as per track set-up in the correct manner and direction will result in a non-timed run.**
7. Judges of Fact have been appointed at these and other locations all around the Track to monitor and report on any incident that may occur which is not in keeping within the rules and spirit of the Event.

8. Re-runs will **ONLY** be given subject to verification by a Judge of Fact.
9. When past Finish Line/Chequered Flag at end of Lap 2 please **SLOW** down and follow Marshals instructions for returning to Paddock/Service Area - **10 MPH MAX SPEED LIMIT!!**
10. The prize giving will take place at the sign on hanger immediately after the event has ended and the results are final.
11. All Competitors will start in Class order starting with Class 1, 2, 3, etc and must be ready when called forward. Dual Entries – Drivers competing in a dual entry, Second driver must be ready at start area to change over as soon as possible after First has finished his/her run in their Class. There must be no speeding in the Paddock – **10 MPH MAX SPEED LIMIT!!**
12. A large Spill Kit will be provided for the Paddock Area as per MSA Yearbook E 7.5
13. Ground Sheets **MUST** be used in the Paddock Area for the Servicing of all vehicles
