SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

'Held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations'

- 1 Enniskillen Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubman Status Rally Time Trial on Saturday 14th July 2018 at Carn Quarry, 41 Carn Road, Irvinestown, Co Fermanagh, BT93 1HA.
- 2 The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions which the organising Club may issue for the event.
- 3 MSA Permit Number 104718 has been issued for the event.
- 4 The event is open to all fully elected members of Enniskillen Motor Club Ltd and is the 3rd round of the Enniskillen Motor Club Ltd Championship for drivers.
- 5 All entrants and drivers must produce a valid Competition Licence and Club membership (National 'B' Stage Rally or above).
- 6 The programme of the meeting will be as follows:
Scrutiny – Saturday 14th July 2018 from 08:00 to 10:00hrs.
Any Competitor not signed on by 10:00hrs on Saturday 14th July 2018 will be excluded as per R 5.1.1.
NB: The organisers WILL NOT extend this time for any Competitor. At scrutiny, cars will be examined for compliance with tyre and vehicle safety regulations as well as for Class eligibility. Entrants should have full knowledge of the car as to its eligibility for the Class entered. All vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations J and R 46 – 48. A noise test will be carried out prior to vehicle scrutiny as per R 4; maximum limit is 100dBa (as per R 4.1.2).

Competitors will be given the opportunity to walk the route prior to the first official timed run which will start at 11:00hrs

- 7 The length of the course is approximately 1.1 miles and consists of a mixed surface of loose and concrete.
- 8 Starting order will be determined by Competition Number and Class. This will be strictly enforced. Cars will start in single file and at 30 second intervals.
The starting signal will be visual.
The finish line will be indicated by Stage Rally Finish Boards.
Method of timing will be electronically activated digital watches.
Results will be based on a cumulative time – best two out of five runs.
Re-runs are not permitted (R25.6.7)
The Stage maximum is five minutes
- 9 Competitors will be identified by competition numbers displayed on both sides of the competing car in accordance with J 4.
- 10 The event will consist of 9 classes as follows:
Class 1 – Group N cars up to and including 2000cc
Class 2 – Group N cars over 2000cc
Class 3 – Clubman (Group A and modified) up to 1450cc
Class 4 – Clubman (Group A and modified) from 1451cc up to 1650cc, not having more than two valves per cylinder
Class 5 – Clubman (Group A and modified) from 1451cc up to 1650cc having more than two valves per cylinder
Class 6 – Clubman (Group A and modified) from 1651cc up to 2100cc, not having more than two valves per cylinder
Class 7 – Clubman (Group A and modified) from 1651cc up to 2100cc, having more than two valves per cylinder
Class 8 – All other eligible 4 Wheel Drive cars (R 46 – 48 & appendix 2) including WRCs
Class 9 – All other eligible 2 Wheel Drive cars (R 46 – 48 & appendix 2)
Turbo engine cars – class determined by capacity x 1.7
Rotary engine cars – class determined by capacity x 2
Protests regarding class eligibility must be made before the commencement of the first official run.
ALL VEHICLES MUST COMPLY WITH MSA REGULATIONS AND HOLD A VALID MOT/NCT CERTIFICATE IF REQUIRED (R 46.1.2). ROAD TAX WILL NOT BE REQUIRED
- 11 Awards will be presented as follows:
1st overall 4wd
1st overall 2wd
Overall winners will forfeit their class awards
1st in each class – trophy
2nd in each class – trophy
3rd in each class – trophy
Ladies Award
Additional awards may be presented at the discretion of the organisers.
- 12 The finish venue will be Carn Quarry. The entry list opens on the publication of these regulations on EMC Ltd's website. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry. The closing date for entries will be Monday 9th July 2018. Entries may also be made online at www.enniskillenmotorclub.co.uk

14 The maximum entry for the meeting is 80. The minimum is 50 and the minimum for each class is 3. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes as necessary.

A competitor will be granted a full refund provided the organisers are notified by the competitor of their inability to compete no later than 18:00hrs on Friday 13th July 2018 therefore please ensure your entry is in early to help with the organising of the event.

16 Provisional results will be published as soon as possible after the event in Carn Quarry where the presentation will take place once results are final.

17 Any protest must be lodged in accordance with C5.

18 Marking and penalties:

- (a) Jump start – no time recorded
- (b) If all wheels of a car cross a straight line between any 2 markers or otherwise leave the track, no time is recorded (Judge of Fact – all signed on marshals). In addition, the car shall stop and not proceed until instructed to do so by an official/marshal.
- (c) Any competitor travelling against rally traffic whilst on the track – exclusion.
- (d) During official runs, if any competitor fails to compete in class and number order, they will forfeit that competitive run.
- (e) If any competitor fails to start their run when instructed to do so by an official, no time will be recorded for that run.
- (f) In the event of a tie, the competitor who achieves the fastest time on the first timed run will be judged the winner. If this is not sufficient to resolve the tie, the times of the second, third and fourth timed runs will be taken into consideration.
- (g) Any competitor who practises, reconnoitres or otherwise examines the special stage, or uses any other person(s) to do so on their behalf, will be excluded from the event and reported to the MSA. This will be strictly enforced. Members of the organising committee

who are setting up the event are exempt from this rule – without their help there would be no event.

19 Any vehicle which fails to complete their timed run and is stopped between the start and finish time controls will be removed from the track by means of a 4-wheel drive vehicle at the sole discretion of the organisers.

20 Final instructions 1 will be available for downloading from EMC Ltd website from 13th July 2018.

Please remember that the MSA has a strict policy of zero tolerance of abuse towards any officials, marshals or timekeepers. In the unlikely event that such abuse may occur Enniskillen Motor Club has a resolve to deal with any such incident in the correct manner, which may include any perpetrator being reported to his/her governing body.
